The organisers will not be held responsible for any loss or damage or any injury whatsoever which is suffered by or to any entrant, their property or servants which may arise directly or indirectly out of or in connection with this event. It is a condition of acceptance of entry that every entrant shall indemnify the WDBA and landowners against any claim or damage, loss or injury that results directly or indirectly from any action or negligence on the part of the entrant.

The decision of the WDBA on any matter shall be final.

Protective headgear, to BSI kite mark PAS015 or BS EN1384 must be worn with harness properly adjusted and fastened.

The WDBA recommend that you wear high-visibility clothing and consider wearing a body protector.

Carry a mobile phone and have some ID on your horse, preferably on the saddle, in case you part company!

Juniors and children must be accompanied by an adult.

Horses and ponies must be aged four years or over to take part.

The WDBA reserve the right to refuse entry to any horse/pony, which in the WDBA's opinion, is unsound or in an unfit condition.

Familiarise yourself with and adhere to the latest edition of the Highway Code.

Any rider seen to be riding irresponsibly and/or failing to comply with stewards' instructions will be asked to leave.

You are responsible for controlling your horse and preventing it being involved in accidents.

The ride has access to some private land for this event only. No access is permitted at any other time.

You will be allocated a start time. Please be at the start five minutes before time given.

You must pass through the finish to be registered as "returned".

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

Horses must not be tied and left unattended and all droppings must be removed from lorry park. No haynets are to be fed to horses outside of lorries or trailers.

Note: Cameras and recording equipment are allowed at the event and by entering you are accepting that your image may be taken and used in WDBA promotional material.

Important Information About The Ride

The Course: Approx. 10 miles over Thursley and Hankley Commons. Course stewards will assist with directions and road crossings. Horse's heart rate will be checked at the start and 20 minutes after you finish.

Queries and Late Entries: Closing date for entries: Friday 21 April 2017. Late entries: £5 extra per rider. we advise you enter early to avoid disappointment. Call 07900 681376 to check availability.

Riding with Friends? Requests to ride together should be made at the time of entry (max 5 riders per group).

Start Times: Times available on www.equoevents.co.uk from **2pm Friday 28 April 2017**, or phone 01483 850476 on Friday 28 April 2017 between 7.00pm and 9.00pm.

ON THE DAY: On arrival, book in with the Secretary. £10 refundable cash deposit is required for each number tabard.

Venue: Parking and Start / Finish is off Portsmouth Road (A3100), Milford. Entrance is 100 yards on right after Sandy Lane (approx. GU8 5BJ). Note: There are no water or toilet facilities onsite.

DIRECTIONS: From A3, take the Milford exit. Follow A283, signposted A3 Portsmouth / Milford / Godalming. At second set of traffic lights, follow signs to A3 Portsmouth / Hindhead (Portsmouth Road). Continue on Portsmouth Road, passing Moushill Lane on left. Venue is on the right, approx. 100 yards after Sandy Lane and opposite the triangular horse and pony warning road sign. Entrance will have WDBA signage.
